

 - Visits of industry executives and practicing engineers to the Institute for seeing research work and laboratories, discussions and delivering lectures on industrial practices, trends and experiences.

She told that the department faculty and students are attending online courses conducted by NPTEL. The progress will be achieved in the forthcoming years.

- Real time products, Society oriented products which are developed by the students are appreciated by the IQAC members. The coordinator narrates the student participation in the events / technical competitions organized by the premier institutions.

- > Director instructed the HODs Internal Hackathons SIH 2020 to be conducted in the Departments.

Methods to improve results, placement and higher studies, various club activities

- Academic peers suggested that, On Saturdays, tutorial classes are to be arranged for problematic subjects to improve the problem analysis skills of the students. Additional hours are allotted for problematic papers.

Similarly, there is an urgent need to prepare engineering students for jobs in multinational companies, by exposing them to newer technologies and engineering methodologies. These objectives can only be achieved well by bridging the gap between industry and the academic institute.

To improve Outcome Based Education(OBE)

- Alumni suggested that more importance is to be given for Outcome Based Education (OBE). Design oriented teaching will be an effective method for obtaining better understanding of the subject and good outcome.
- Academic peers suggested, university curriculum maintains the balance in the composition of basic science, humanities, professional courses and their distribution in core and electives. To a major extent our curriculum helps in attaining the POs and PSOs. However, some components may not be included in the curriculum provided by the University. The curriculum gaps in the current syllabus is to be identified by comparing various university curriculums, these gaps will be fulfilled by arranging guest lectures or by arranging special lectures by the faculty based on their expertise.
- In order to fill the curricular gaps, the department have to take additional efforts to impart such knowledge by co-curricular, extracurricular and extension activities which is beyond the syllabus content.

Awards and achievements

- The Director presented the benchmarks for academic departments, notable events of the SMVEC, INSTITUTION INNOVATION COUNCIL –MHRD has recognized SMVEC as a Best Performing Institution Innovation Council from the South Zone (SRO) during IIC Calendar year 2018-19.
