





17.1 Review of 16th meeting

- ➤ He listed that a total of 10 Online Certification Courses were underwent by staff and student till Third quarter.

17.5 Exam Related Activities

- ➤ Dr. S. Jayakumar, Controller of Examinations presented on Conduction of End Semester Examinations for B.Tech, M.Tech, B.Arch, MCA and MBA programmes February/ March 2021.
- ➤ He also presented End Semester Examination Question Paper Pattern and Result Analysis by comparing with previous year Pondicherry University results.

17.6 R&D and Consultancy activities

- ➤ Dr.K. Velmurugan, Dean-Research, presented on Research Forum activities. He detailed on the institution seed money of target Rs.10,00,000/-.
- ➤ He presented the target of Rs. 32,23,000/- for grants to be received from Government and Non-Governmental agencies.
- ➤ He presented the target for Number of departments having research projects funded by Government and Non-Government agencies during the year 2020-21 is 37 and 18 was attained in the third quarters and remaining 19 will be achieved in the fourth quarter.
- ➤ He presented the Research Proposals submitted by all the departments to various funding agencies for the total amount of Rs.9,97,74,213/-
- ▶ He presented the detail on funds received from AICTE through various schemes (Institutional development schemes, Faculty Development schemes, STTP, MODROB, ATAL-FDP and Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre for SC/ST Students)
- ➤ He presented that the publication of research papers in care journals is 314 for the Academic year 2020-2021 and 183 were published in the first three quarters and remaining 131 will be achieved in the fourth quarter.

- > He presented that the Total number of Citations in Scopus/Web of Science during the year 2020-21 is 222 and they were cited in the first three quarters
- ➤ Consultancy works target amount of Rs.59,24,000/- was fixed. In that Rs.31,84,000/- was achieved in the first three quarters and the remaining amount of Rs. 27,40,000/- is planned for 4th quarter.
- ➤ He presented that the Patent published is 44 in national level and 6 patents granted in international level from various departments in first three quarters.
- ➤ He highlighted that there are 32 faculties pursuing their PhD Programme from various departments.

- > Dr. N.S.N. Cailassame, Placement Officer presented the Placed students details with salary package and also presented the details of Dream offers.
- ➤ A total of 633 students were placed in 2017-2021 batch till April 2021. In which the dream offers are 141 with the salary package ranges between 4 lakhs to 7 lakha.
- ➤ He also presented on the Internship, Institute Industry Interaction details and plan of Placement Activities for the Academic year 2021-2022.

- ➤ He presented that Sri Manakula Vinayagar Engineering College has Ranked 46th among the top 100 Private Institution in India in DATAQUEST and Ranked 57th among the top 100 Government T- Schools Overall in India in DATAQUEST -T-SCHOOL
- ➤ He presented that Sri Manakula Vinayagar Engineering College has Ranked 188th Ranking National Level in Marketing and Development Research Associates (MDRA) in India Today Ranking
- > He pointed out the college participation in Various Ranking such as NIRF Ranking, ATAL Ranking, India Today, Data-Quest, Silicon-India etc.,
- > He also presented the comparison of various colleges are in the bandwidth of 150-200 NIRF Ranking and it can be taken as the benchmark for each criteria.

- ➤ Training Activities were presented by Dr. J. Madhusudhanan, Head/Artificial Intelligence and Data Science Engineering / Training Coordinator. He explained on the various training activities for the Period June 2020-March 2021.
- ➤ He also listed the various Employability and Enhancement courses conducted for the students in the first three quarters and plan of training Activities for the Academic year 2021-2022.

17.10 Any other matters with the permission of the Chair

- The Academic Expert Dr. N. Alagumurthi has shared the following suggestions.
- ➤ Appreciated the entire proceedings of the 17th IQAC presentation and lauded for a tremendous changes in presenting various activities of 3rd quarter and plan of activities for 4th quarter
- ➤ Suggested to explore the possibilities of celebrating IQAC day and invite eminent academic experts for presenting on the topics related to "National Educational Policy" and give-away IQAC awards to staff who has done exemplary work in the department and an award can be introduced as "The best IQAC Department" which has carried out more activities and achievements. This will motivate staff and department to explore more on their areas.
- > Suggested to publish IQAC magazines/ Newsletter/ handbook in periodic interval to exhibit the work carried out in the institution for better perspective among the stakeholders.
- > Suggested that the targets fixed in each quarter need to be honored in that quarter itself to avoid overburden in the final quarter
- > Suggested to add clubs, chapters and association to strengthen the entrepreneurship cell. To this comment, the placement officer Dr.N.S.N. Caillassame explained the conduction of weekly webinar on different topics. The successful entrepreneurs are as resource person through "Kanavugal Meipada" programme organized by Innovative Services.
- > Highlighted the importance of physical infrastructure establishment of technological incubation centre for startup activities.
- > Pointed out that in next meeting a report on administrative and academic audit need to be presented.
- ➤ Suggested some of the funding agencies for TBI through MSME, NSDC, UGC (Vocational Courses), NSQF (Startup assistance, new certification courses etc.,), NSTEDB (Technological incubation), Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India and more funds are available through Unnat Abiyan schemes offered by AICTE.
- As the internal revenue generation is very less, the academic expert asked to have MOU's with companies in and around Puducherry for conducting lectures to company people by the staff and generate revenue through them

- ➤ He asked the IQAC coordinators to highlight the staff along with their department who has published their research work in reputed journal with their high H-Index, more citation index and High Impact factor. This will motivate other staff to publish their research works.
- ➤ He also pointed out to present the number of students appearing in GATE examination and other competitive examination such as GRE, TOFEL etc., and the number of students pursuing their higher education in national and international institutions.
- > Emphasized to think on the collaboration of institute with other Universities for student and faculty exchange programme in future.
- Suggested to carry out CSR activities through SMVEC foundation to improve the college perspective among the different stake holders.
- ➤ Wished for institution success in getting some good place in NIRF ranking submitted for the year 2019-20.
- > Need to concentrate on admission from other states and International Students.
- ➤ Director cum Principal appreciated all the members of IQAC for their interactive participation and their valuable suggestions to improve the quality of our college in all the aspects.
- ➤ Dr. J. Abbas Mohaideen, Registrar felicitated the IQAC meeting and appreciated the efforts taken by the IQAC cell in organizing the meeting successfully and thanked the Academic expert for his valuable suggestions for the betterment of institution.
