Quality Initiatives Through IQAC

IQAC Coordinator Dr.A.A.Arivalagar, presented the following quality initiatives taken by IQAC in the second quarter of Academic Year 2023-24 to the expert members

- Review of Non-Statutory Committee 31 Committees are reviewed and members list is updated
- Review of Functional Professional Chapters 20 Professional chapters are assigned with name of the coordinator for each chapter
- Review of Functional various Clubs 36 Clubs are identified and the functioning of these clubs are monitored and the report is made ready
- Silver Jubilee Celebration Roles and responsibilities for various events are assigned to faculties on account of celebration of 25 years of institutional academic excellence.
- Conduction of External Peer Review Audit Internal audit was performed by the institution senior faculty members of different disciplines and External peer audit was conducted as by Prof. Dr.S.Subbaraj, Principal, T J Institute of Technology, Chennai and Prof.Dr.Dillibabu Ramalingam, Professor/Department of Industrial Engineering, College of Engineering, Guindy. The comments on their observation in the audit were rectified and the action taken report of the same was received from various departments.
- Conduction of ESE Process Quality Audit by CoE To assess the quality of End Semester
 Examination process and valuation, an exam audit was carried out by the Controller of
 Examinations. The findings of the audit were recorded and the scope of improvement is
 documented
- Review of Universal Human Values I and II by Faculty Members are constantly
 monitored and work towards the achievement of 100% of faculty members to get certified in
 these courses.
- Admission for the Academic year 2024 Various centers planned Various admission centers in and around Puducherry and northern states are planned to have a diverse student population inside the campus. It is also planned to start around 6 new centers in Tamil Nadu
- Industry based Laboratories Initiated discussion with TVS-TS, Chennai in establishing a
 CoE in the area of e-Vehicle and related courses to meet the recent market trends. Also,
 efforts are made to have a Memorandum of Understanding to establish a center of excellence
 with TCS in the area of PLM and IoT
- Development of e-Content in Green Matt Studio The Institution has established Educational Materials Resource Development Units (Green Matte Studio and Idea Lab) during 2023-24. These Units Facilitates the faculty members to create video lectures and other e-contents to be uploaded in the Institutional Website. Initially Lectures for 20 different





subjects of various Branches were Captured. It is decided to develop a minimum of 20 hours lectures for each course in the upcoming Academic Year.

Formation of Institutional Social Responsibility Cell (IRC) – To integrate the various committees and cells related to Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan, NSS, NILA CRS, Literary Association, Physical Education and Women Empowerment Cell the Institutional Social Responsibility Cell is formed to oversee the effective implementation of all activities planned, involve every student in any one of the activity and prepare a detailed report on the activities.

To Apprise and Review of Academic Activities - Implementation of R-2023, Adherence to academic Calendar, Student enrolment and details, first year student Induction program, Value Added Courses, Professional Chapters, Clubs, Faculty Empowerment Program, Details of certification courses, curricular and co-curricular activities during the second quarter of academic year 2023-2024

Dr.S.Anbumalar, Dean Academics (Circuit), apprised the following salient features on the curricular and co -curricular activities performed during the second quarter of the Academic Year 2023-2024.

- Implementation of R-2023 Regulations Modifications carried out in B. Tech Regulations with respect to R-2020 into R 2023 such as programme structure, curriculum structure (inclusion of Universal Human Values (UHV-II), Theory cum Practical Courses, Micro and Mini Project, Sustainable Development Goal (SDGs) courses NEP 2020) are presented to the external expert and internal IQAC members. All the above changes were made with approval from the concerned Board of Studies of all programmes and subsequently got ratified in the Academic Council and Governing Body.
 - The new PG Programmes are included in R-2023
 - (i) M.Tech Artificial Intelligence and Data Science;
 - (ii) M.Tech-Computer Science Engineering (Big Data Analytics)
 - The PG Programmes removed from R-2020
 - (i) M.Tech Networking
 - (ii) M.Tech Power Electronics and Drives
- Academic Calendar The Academic calendar has been prepared for all programmes and it has been followed. Academic Calendar has the following contents

- Students Enrolment Details A total of 1165 students has been enrolled in the Undergraduate Programmes and 69 students as lateral admission. A total of 353 students are admitted in PG programme which includes M.Tech, MBA and MCA
- First Year Students Induction Programme Students Induction Programme is made mandatory for I Year/ I semester students to get acquainted to Socializing, Associating, Governing and Experiencing in physical activity, creative and performing arts, literary activities etc.,
- NPTEL Courses A total of 492 students and 23 Faculty members are certified through
 NPTEL programme during the second quarter of the Academic Year 2023-2024.
- Certification Courses 19, 754 students are trained in the International Associate Level Certification courses through various center of excellence established by train lab academy, Bangalore during the second quarter of the Academic Year 2023-2024
- Faculty Empowerment Programmes A total of 98 faculty members have attended various faculty development programme and short term training programme during the second quarter of this Academic Year
- Value added courses, clubs 163 value added courses and 168 club activities are conducted in various departments to enhance the skill level of the students to meet the industrial requirements and promote themselves as an ethical professional at the end of the course.

To Discuss and Apprise on Evaluation process and external auditing process conducted during the second quarter of Academic Year 2023-2024

Controller of Examinations, Dr.S.Jayakumar briefed on the conduction and evaluation processes followed in End Semester Examination in the examination section

- End Semester Examination The start and end dates of the End Semester Examination
 along with the conduction of supplementary examinations for various semesters of
 undergraduate and post graduate programmes are presented. Valuation of answer script and
 the dates of publication of results with its analysis of department wise pass percentages are
 briefed to the members present.
- Complaints/Grievances Against Evaluation 3% of Percentage of complaints/ grievance against evaluation was received in the ESE held on August/September 2023 for Under Graduate programme and 8% of complaint against evaluation was received for Supplementary Examinations for MBA.
- Examination Audit Academic experts from the reputed institutions were invited to audit the
 question papers, answer keys and randomly selected answer-scripts awarded with high,





average and low marks. The committees members have given suggestions on the following points

- 1) Higher order Bloom's Level has to be incorporated in the question papers
- 2) GATE questions can be incorporated in the Continuous Assessment Test
- 3) Academic Bank of Credit can be introduced
