POLICY FOR ADMISSION OF SRI MANAKULA VINAYAGAR ENGINEERING COLLEGE, PUDUCHERRY

INTRODUCTION

Our Institution is an autonomous college is known for its holistic and value-based approach to education with experiential wisdom. The College offers a wide range of programs at the undergraduate, post graduate and Ph.D in Engineering, Management Studies, Computer Applications and Architecture. This policy is for effective, fair and smooth implementation of admission process for different courses offered by the College that reflects the institution's values, goals and mission of offering affordable and inclusive education to all sections of society. It defines the admission process for all under graduate, post graduate and PhD programs offered by the College in various schools. Policy lays down the Standard operating procedures for the admission process up to completion of enrolment at the affiliated University and cancellation of admission if any.

OBJECTIVES

- To define the eligibility criterion for all courses offered by the College
- To specify the prerequisites in form of documentary evidence of eligibility for admission, avail seats reserved under different criterion, avail fee concessions for admission to courses offered by the College
- To specify the process of admission to different programs offered by the College
- To create confidence in the students and other stakeholders that the system is transparent, fair and not cumbersome

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GETTING ADMISSION INTO VARIOUS PROGRAMMES

1. FOR ENGINEERING

The candidate seeking admission to any under graduate course must have completed H.Sc. from any recognized Board and must have passed in all subjects at the time of admission. Diploma qualification is required for Lateral Entry admissions in B.Tech. Candidates have to fulfil the admission requirements as prescribed by Pondicherry University and also appropriate apex body such as AICTE- New Delhi.

UG PROGRAMMES: Bachelor of Technology [B.Tech.] (From the Approved intake, 50% is Government Quota through CENTAC and 50% is Management Quota through CETPPEC)

Candidates should have passed the +2 (H.Sc.) (Academic) examination [conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu, or any other equivalent examination] thereto, with a minimum of 45% marks for General category (40% marks for OBC / BCM / MBC/EBC/BT/SC/ST - Candidates) in aggregate, in the prescribed subjects, namely, Mathematics, Physics and any one of the following optional subjects: Chemistry/ Bio-Technology / Computer Science / Information Technology / Informatics Practices/ Technical Vocational Subject / Agriculture / Engineering Graphics / Business Studies / Biology / (Botany & Zoology). And for a specialised courses like B.Tech (Fashion Technology), the Mathematics subject is not mandatory as per the Guidelines of AICTE.

B.Tech - Lateral Entry (10% of the approved intake, in which 50% is Government Quota through CENTAC and 50% is Management Quota through CETPPEC)

For Lateral entry into third semester of the eight semester B.Tech Degree programme: The minimum qualification for admission is a pass in three year diploma or four year sandwich diploma course in Engineering / Technology with a minimum of 45% marks for General Category (40% for OBC/BCM/MBC/EBC/BT/SC candidates) in aggregate in the subjects covered from third to final semester [or] a pass in any B.Sc. course with Mathematics as one of the subjects of study with a minimum of 45% marks for General category (40% for OBC/BCM/MBC/EBC/BT/SC/ST candidates) in aggregate in main and Academic Regulations 2020 (R-2020) nine ancillary subjects excluding language subjects.

Age Limit

- The candidate should not have completed 21 years of age as on 1st July of the Academic year under consideration. In case of SC/ST candidates, the age limit is relaxable for three years. No age limit for Lateral entry to the second year of the B.Tech degree programme.

PG PROGRAMMES IN M.TECH/MANAGEMENT STUDIES/COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (From the Approved intake, 50% is Government Quota through CENTAC and 50% is Management Quota through PG CET) AND Ph. D

- For PG in Engineering, MBA/MCA and Ph.D. (Regular-Full Time, Part—Time) programmes both eligibility and age limit as per the norms of Pondicherry University/AICTE/UGC.

2. SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE (From the Approved intake, 50% is Government Quota through CENTAC and 50% is Management Quota through CETPPEC)

Candidates need to pass the 10+2 level from any recognized board of education or equivalent exam. Provided No Candidate shall be admitted to Architecture course unless she/ he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma with mathematics as the one of the compulsory subject as per the norms and regulations of the competing authority (i.e) Council of Architecture.

All candidates need to qualify an Aptitude Test conducted by Council (i.e. NATA/JEE) for admission to B.Arch, Course. Therefore, all candidates who have passed in any other aptitude test in Architecture conducted by other authorities shall also be required to qualify NATA in order to be eligible for admission to the B.Arch. Course

REFUND OF FEES

On request, in case any cancellation of admission before commencement of classes, refund of fee will be processed by the Administrative Office of the institution upon receiving approval from the Management and will be paid only by crossed cheque in the name of the student or father/guardian.
