IQAC Coordinator has presented following initiatives to the expert members for their insights and useful comments as a part of continuous improvement

#### **IQAC Day Celebration**

March 13 is celebrated as Institutional IQAC Day since its inception. This year two eminent experts, Dr. R.S. Valarmathi, Professor and Dean of the School of Electrical and Communication Engineering and Dr. S. Ravichandran, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering from Vel

Tech Rangarajan, Dr. Sagunthala R & D Institute of Technology, (*Deemed to be University*), Avadi, Chennai conducted a one-day seminar on "Pedagogy in Teaching Learning and Assessment" on March 14, 2025, Seminar hall, Third Floor. Totally 87 faculty members attended the program and stand benefitted.

#### **IQAC** Calendar

IQAC event calendar for the academic year 2024-25 was presented before the expert members for their suggestions and ratification.

#### Institution Development Plan

The Co-ordinator also apprised the sequence of preparation process of Institution Development Plan 2026 - 2035 (10-year plan) which involved the formation of IDP Core Committee, Situational Analysis, Stakeholder Consultation, Defining Vision, Mission, and aligning Goals, Strategic Planning, Budget Planning and Resource Mobilization, Drafting the IDP Document, Internal Review and adopted.

Then the Institution Development Plan 2026-2035 was presented to the committee for their approval. The key focus of this IDP is to ensure Holistic and Inclusive growth, Digital empowerment, Enhancing Employability, fostering entrepreneurship, Integrating skill-based courses, Internationalization, Faculty and student exchange programs and Collaborative partnerships. The IDP was drafted based on the University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines including eight enablers.

Then the approval process was also placed before the IQAC committee which consists of Presentation to Internal Authorities namely College Development Council (CDC), then IQAC. Then it will be placed before the Academic Council and Governing Body for approval and ratification. After the process, this will be hosted in the college website and submitted to external bodies if required.

## Targets for the Academic Year 2025-2026

Targets for the Academic Year 2025-2026 in line with the institutional vision for continuous quality enhancement and NAAC accreditation parameters was assigned to all the departments and informed. All department heads are requested to align their yearly plans with the targets and in turn they submitted an action plan how it is planned to be executed in four quarters of the coming academic year 2025-26.

## Academic and Administrative Audit for Odd semester of Academic Year 2023-2024.

The Internal Academic and Administrative Audit was conducted from March 7-8, 2025, for all undergraduate programs and post graduate programs. The report of the Academic and Administrative Audit, including observations and actions taken, was submitted to the IQAC for approval.

## Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs)

The Co-ordinator also apprised about Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) updating to the expert members. Total number of MoUs Signed during the fourth Quarter is 5 and during the academic year 2024-25 is 15 and in total, 84 functional MoUs are available in force.

## Non-statutory committees, Professional Bodies and Clubs

The Co-ordinator also apprised details about functioning of 34 non-statutory committees, 16 professional bodies and 45 department clubs and its updation about its composition for the academic year 2025–2026.

#### IQAC 2025.07.29.3

To apprise and review of Academic activities and events including Silver Jubilee celebration conducted during the fourth quarter of academic year 2024-2025.

Dr.S.Anbumalar, Dean Academic, apprised the following details to all the members present in the meeting

- Dean-Academics briefed about the 9<sup>th</sup> BoS conducted with dates for all programs of engineering and department of management studies and computer applications.
- Dean-Academics summarized the total of number of invited lectures 167 conducted against the target of 164, seminars 37 and workshops / hands on training 39 during the fourth quarter.
- Dean-Academics also detailed about the number of activities conducted under NSS (16 Nos), Swachh Bharat (16 Nos), Gender sensitization (17 Nos) and extension activities (16 Nos) during the fourth quarter.
- Dean-Academics also detailed about the contribution of IIC in Yukthi -Innovation Repository wherein 904 students registered, 195 innovations were submitted. Finally, 112 innovations were recommended.
- Dean-Academics also highlighted the participation of Institution in SMARTMED 2025 (Strategic Meet in Academic Research Transfer in Medical Devices) during May 23-25, 2025 organized by AICTE and MoE, Punjab State Council for Technology and DST-TEC, Punjab university, Chandigarh. Totally eight proposals in interdisciplinary nature were submitted and five teams have reached to the advanced Level.
- She also highlighted the successful participation of students and faculty members in NPTEL programs during May-June 2025 as a process of continuous empowerment through self-learning. Totally 5621 students enrolled and 2053 students registered for exams. 1388 students have cleared the NPTEL exams successfully. Out of 443 staff members enrolled, 67 registered for exams and 48 have cleared the exams successfully. Out of 47 mentors assigned, 38 have received Mentors certificates, out of which two staff members received Gold Medal and 16 received Elite Medal Mentor certificates.
- Dean Academics apprised the members that SMVEC in its sustained effort to cultivate civic awareness and democratic engagement among youth, actively participated in the "Viksit Bharat Yuva Connect" Viksit Bharat Yuva Connect An initiative of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports by Government of India. The institution hosted a Mock Youth Parliament and Debate Competition on 28th July 2025, exploring the impactful theme "The Emergency Period in India." The event served as a platform to deepen students' understanding of constitutional values, the evolution of democratic governance, and the significance of informed dialogue in fostering civic responsibility. Furthering its engagement with the initiative, SMVEC students successfully registered on the My Bharat Portal, reinforcing institutional support for national-level developmental outreach and inclusive youth participation.
- She also detailed about the silver jubilee celebration happened during last quarter of the academic year. Totally 90 events were conducted which include Celestia grand Cultural Day, Azure Al Day, Jubilation Day and Documentary Screening of our Institution during 25 years to all staff members.

Dr.N.S.N. Cailassame, Dean-Placement presented the activities carried out by the Training and Placement Cell during the Fourth Quarter of the Academic Year 2024-2025.

- Aptitude, technical and company specific trainings were imparted to the students through various renowned training institutes namely FACE, SMART Training Resources, Innate talent, and Talent 64.
- Students were also trained in Assessment Platform, Programming platform and Aptitude Platform through AON, Skill Rack, Aptitude Buster and SHL.
- Totally 1000 plus offers were obtained by students during the Academic year 2024-25. He
  also highlighted totally 65 companies visited our campus for recruitment. He made a detailed
  presentation on details of students placed department wise, pay band wise to the expert
  members.
- He also presented the details about the internship underwent by students. Totally 839 students have undergone internship, out of which 154 students were paid stipend. It was observed that the highest stipend was Rs 35000/-
