Requirements for Appearing End **Semester Examination**

A student is expected to maintain 100% attendance in all courses as attendance also carries internal marks. A student will be qualified to appear for end semester examinations of a semester only if he/she satisfies the below mentioned requirements.

The student is permitted to appear for End Semester Examinations, only if he/she maintains minimum 75% of attendance. If he/she secured attendance greater than or equal to 60 % and less than 75 % has to pay the necessary condonation prescribed by the college authority with necessary supporting documents for his/her absence.

Redo Category

A student who secures overall attendance less than 60% has to repeat the course with the approval, when it is next offered.
