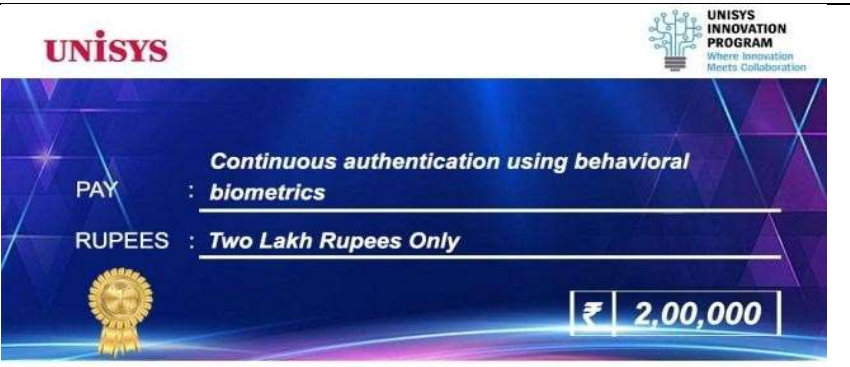
Sandhiya B., a III Year student, was a finalist in the CII Puducherry Innovation Contest organized by CII Puducherry on 30th October 2021.

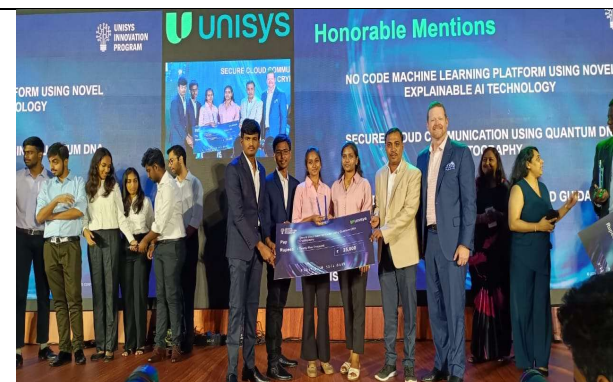
