Composition of Committee:

1. The Principal as the Chairman, Ex-officio
2. The senior most staff will be the Member Secretary of the Committee.
3. NSS Coordinator will act as a Coordinator
4. One faculty from each department assigned as member

Term: the term of the *Extension Activity Committee* shall be two years.

Meetings: The *Extension Activity Committee* shall meet once in a month.

Note: Each department will have internal members for *Extension Activity Committee* to execute the activities.

The Extension Activity Committee is constituted to promote social responsibility, community engagement, environmental consciousness, and holistic development among students through meaningful extension and outreach activities. The committee shall perform the following functions:

1. To identify and inculcate a spirit of discipline, leadership, social responsibility, creativity, and physical and mental well-being among students through extension activities.
2. To organize voluntary blood donation camps, tree plantation drives, medical camps, and other community service programmes on important national and international occasions.
3. To conduct seminars, workshops, and awareness programmes on issues of local, regional, national, and global importance, particularly for the benefit of adopted villages.
4. To promote cleanliness, hygiene, and sanitation in adopted villages through regular awareness campaigns and community participation.
5. To facilitate basic healthcare services by organizing medical camps, health screening programmes, and preventive healthcare awareness activities in adopted villages.
6. To create awareness among the public on sanitation, health, environmental protection, civic responsibilities, and other social issues.
7. To provide educational resources, career guidance, skill development programmes, and academic support for school students and villagers.
8. To create awareness about employment opportunities and facilitate access to government and non-government employment schemes for unemployed youth.
9. To promote Solid Waste Management practices by organizing awareness programmes, training sessions, and community-based waste management initiatives.
10. To organize social welfare programmes and public awareness campaigns in collaboration with Nila Community Radio Station (Nila CRS).
11. To ensure the cleanliness and maintenance of the college campus, including academic buildings, toilets, gardens, electrical facilities, drinking water systems, and to monitor the quality of services provided by the college canteen and hostels.
12. To coordinate and support voter awareness programmes and activities in association with the Election Department for promoting electoral literacy and democratic participation.

13. To collaborate with Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), Government Departments, and other agencies in organizing social service, environmental, health, and community development programmes.
14. To initiate and coordinate applications for State and National awards related to Swachh Bharat, Green Campus, environmental sustainability, community engagement, and other extension activities.
15. To encourage students to actively participate in community service programmes that contribute to sustainable development and nation-building while fostering values of empathy, citizenship, and social commitment.
